INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Please complete all of the above if it is not already completed.
2. Dogs are required to be licensed in the town within thirty (30) days of being acquired or turning six (6) months of age in accordance with Massachusetts General Law Ch. 140 , S. 137a\*
3. Please mail dog(s) current rabies certificate(s) with this application. The certificate(s) will be returned with your dog license(s), if requested. If a rabies certificate is required but not included, a license cannot be issued.
4. You may license your dog(s) during regular business hours, but mailing to the above address is encouraged. Enclose a self-addressed **STAMPED** envelope (the post office has requested that **2 STAMPS** be used due to the bulk of the tags). **If a self-addressed stamped envelope is not included this application cannot be processed.**
5. Make your check payable to the Town of Huntington. **DO NOT MAIL CASH!**
6. Licenses expire annually on June 30<sup>th</sup>. A late fee of \$20.00 per dog plus the licensing fee will be charged for applications received after June 30<sup>th</sup> if your dog was in town and you failed to license it. If you have more than three (3) dogs, you will need a Kennel License.
